



International Supercomputing Conference to Offer Largest-Ever HPC Exhibition on June 23-25 in Hamburg

HAMBURG, Germany – When the 2009 International Supercomputing Conference convenes in the Congress Center Hamburg on June 23-26, the exhibition hall will be filled with more than nearly 120 booths exhibiting the latest systems, services and applications in high performance computing and networking.

The 2009 edition of the exhibition, which is Europe's largest show devoted to high-performance computing, will feature twice as many exhibits as just three years ago. The three-day ISC exhibition is a unique opportunity to learn about the latest trends in HPC, meeting and talking with leading international HPC manufacturers and researchers, who are showcasing their newest products and HPC-solutions.

Advance registration for this year's conference is also outpacing past years' figures by more than 20 percent.

"With our move to Hamburg this year, we wanted to take advantage of the larger exhibition hall and we truly have – with almost 30 percent more booths than last year in Dresden," said ISC'09 Chairman Prof. Hans Meuer of the University of Mannheim. "When we started the conference 24 years ago, I never would have dreamed we would have such a world-class technology exhibition to complement our program of international HPC experts."

The 2009 Exhibition opens Tuesday, June 23, and continues through Thursday, June 25. All attendees registered for the ISC conference program are also admitted to the exhibition. Additionally, special Exhibits Plus Passes are available for those who only want to visit the booths.
