



Call for BoFs

ISC is Europe's premier international conference and exhibition for supercomputing, networking and storage. The four-day conference educates, inspires and brings together some 2,000 attendees and key decision makers from the HPC industry for an intense exchange of ideas and visions. Again taking place in historic Hamburg, Germany, this time from May 30 – June 3, ISC is the best HPC event to attend in 2010 to learn about leading technologies and applications in the fast-growing HPC industry. ISC'10 features an exceptional line-up of speakers, a comprehensive HPC exhibition and many networking opportunities, all just in 96 hours and under one roof.

Birds-of-a-Feather (BoF) sessions are opportunities for conference attendees with common interests to come together for informal discussions and sharing new ideas and information on HPC topics. Each 40-minute session addresses a different topic and is led by one or more individuals with expertise in this area. The 15 BoF sessions are open to all conference participants, including exhibitors, and will be held on Monday, May 31, 1:30 pm – 6:00 pm (BoFs 1–6), and on Thursday, June 3, 9:00 am – 1:00 pm (BoFs 7–15, in parallel).

To suggest a topic for a BoF session, please submit a summary (1,000 characters max.) via the online submission form at www.supercomp.de/isc10/Participate/Call-for-BoFs. The language has to be English, and BoF proposals need to be received by March 21, 2010. The ISC'10 Program Committee will review the submissions, select 15 BoF sessions and
